ALBERT LANE SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE:

- To reward and encourage achievement in vocal music with a stipend of \$500 to be paid to the institution of choice.
- To support and encourage young people who are striving for excellence by providing monetary support and recognition of effort.
- To provide an opportunity for the recipient to perform with the Huntsville Community Chorus.

THE APPLICANT MUST:

- Be a post-high school vocal music student.
 Be a resident of North Alabama to include Madison, Morgan, Limestone, Colbert,
 DeKalb, Franklin, Jackson, Lauderdale and Marshall Counties.
- Demonstrate intentions of pursuing a serious course of vocal music study that meets the approval of the HCCA Scholarship Committee.
- Submit an application form <u>accompanied by an essay of 150 words or less</u> describing the applicant's musical interests and career goals.
- Submit two letters of recommendation to the HCCA Scholarship Committee, at least one of which must be from a music director or voice teacher.
- Audition before the HCCA Scholarship Audition Committee. Applicant will be notified of their audition time.

AUDITION:

The applicant will perform two pieces. (See "Suggested Repertoire")

- HCCA will provide the accompanist.
- The applicant will provide:
 - Original copy of music for accompanist.
 - Three judges' copies, with numbered measures, of all music to be performed. (Photocopies are acceptable.)
- The performance must be from memory.
- The applicant may have to return for additional hearings.

SUGGESTED REPERTOIRE:

- 17th or 18th century art song in original language
- An opera aria
