KENNETH TURVEY SCHOLARSHIP | REQUIREMENTS

PURPOSE:

- To reward and encourage achievement in vocal music with a stipend of \$500 to be paid to the institution of choice.
- To support and encourage young people who are striving for excellence by providing monetary support and recognition of effort.
- To provide an opportunity for the recipient to perform with the Huntsville Community Chorus.

THE APPLICANT MUST:

- Be a graduating high school senior.
- Be a resident of North Alabama to include: Madison, Morgan, Limestone, Colbert, DeKalb, Franklin, Jackson, Lauderdale and Marshall Counties *or* a member of a vocal performing group in the same area.
- Demonstrate intentions of pursuing a serious course of music study that meets the approval of the HCCA Scholarship Committee.
- Submit an application form **accompanied by an essay of 150 words or less** describing the applicant's musical interests and career goals.
- Submit two letters of recommendation to the HCCA Scholarship Committee, at least one must be from a music director or voice teacher.
- Audition before the HCCA Scholarship Audition Committee. Applicants will be notified of time and place upon receipt of all materials.

AUDITION:

- **The performance must be from memory.**
- **The applicant will provide original copy of music for accompanist.**
- **The applicant will perform two pieces.** (See "Suggested Repertoire")
- **HCCA will provide the accompanist.**

SUGGESTED REPERTOIRE:

- 17th or 18th century art song in original language.
- A romantic or contemporary art song in original language.

Please note that applicants for the Turvey Scholarship are discouraged from performing operatic arias.
